GI-275 Crew Profiles

What they are & how to select them

Overview

- Crew Profiles allow the pilot to quickly select a predefined configuration of the GI-275, instead of having to change individual settings.
 - Please do not adjust the individual settings; instead, load the desired crew profile.
 - The table on the next slide describes how each profile is configured.
- Crew Profiles can be loaded from either the ADI (top unit) or HSI (bottom unit).
 - The examples in this how-to are shown from the ADI, but the steps are identical if loaded from the HSI.

Flying 20 Club Crew Profiles

Profile Name	SVT?	Description
Default	depends	The default start-up profile. Configuration depends upon what settings (if any) were changed by the last pilot.
Non-synthetic vision profiles:		
SIMPLE	No	The most basic display possible.
ADVANCED	No	SIMPLE + additional navigation data (e.g. bearing pointer).
FULL	No	All optional features (except SVT) enabled.
Synthetic vision (SVT) profiles:		
SVTSIMP	Yes	SIMPLE + basic SVT.
SVTADV	Yes	ADVANCED + basic SVT (including "airport signs").
SVTFULL	Yes	All optional features (including "horizon headings") enabled.
